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# Project Scope and Objectives

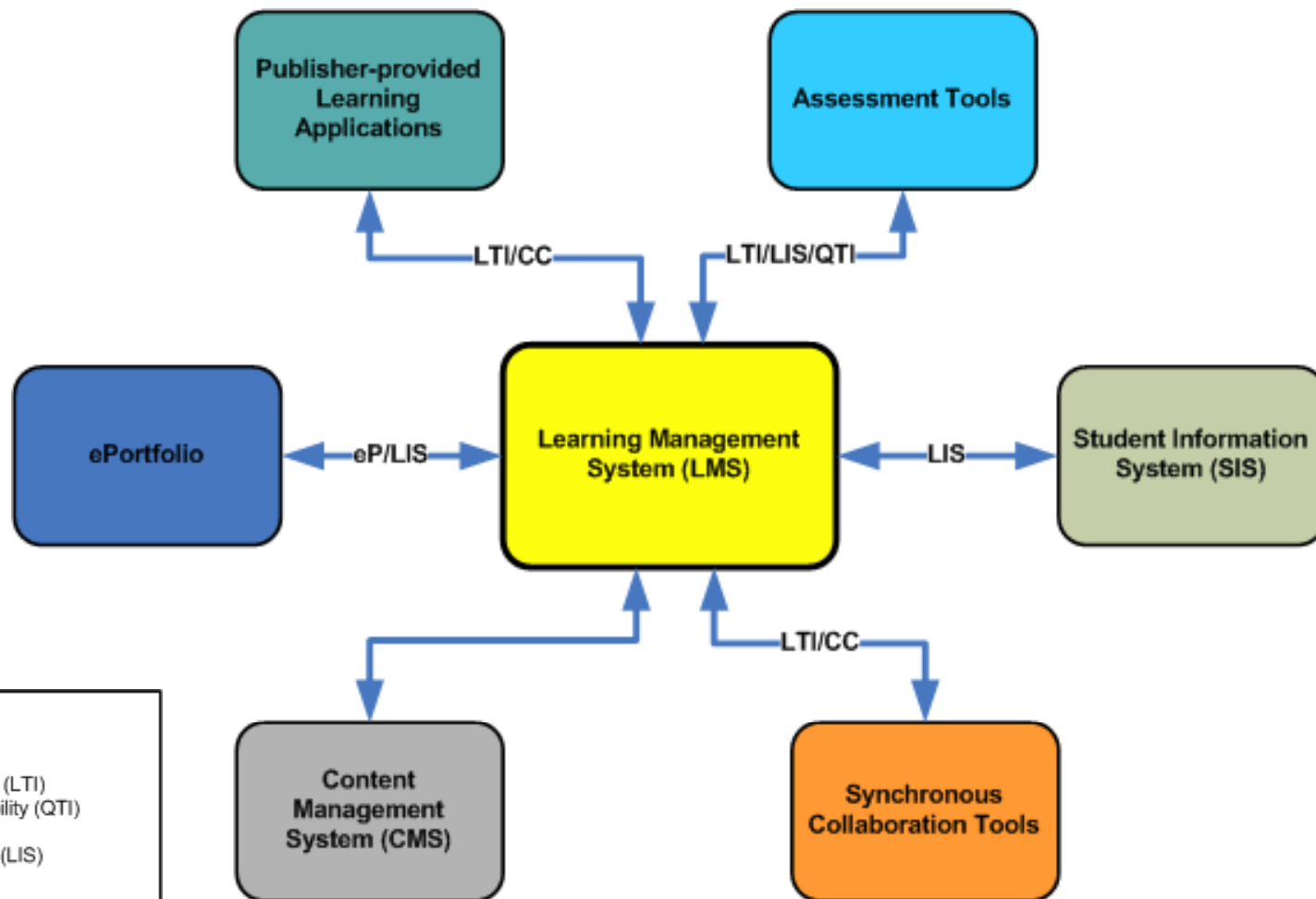
1. Define Functions and Most Common and Useful Features of Key eLearning Systems and Learning Applications as Baseline for RFP Technical Requirements – *defined as independent components:*

- Learning Management System (LMS)
- Content Management System (CMS)
- ePortfolio System
- Publisher-provided Learning Applications
- Synchronous Collaboration Applications
- Assessment Applications

\*\*Tech Requirements Emphasis: SAAS/Web 2.0/Cloud Computing

2. Identification and Functional Definition of Relevant IMS GLC Interoperability Standards (Current and Developing) - Enabling Integration of Key eLearning Systems and Applications
3. **End-product:** Technical Features/Functionality Requirements Baseline (Template) for End-user and Vendor Use During the RFP Process:
  - Template provides baseline technical features and functionality and can be used in whole or in part (or modified to address institutional specific needs) when procuring eLearning systems and applications - either bundled or unbundled
    - Note: Requirements baseline (template) only focused on technical features and functionality section of RFP document – will not include legalize and terms and conditions...
