





Course Overview

Advanced Placement United States History is a full year, general survey course that covers American History from pre-Columbian to the present. The newly redesigned course focuses on historical thinking skills and themes that encourage students to approach the learning of content as if they were historians. Additionally, the course exposes students to extensive primary and secondary sources and to the interpretation of various historical interpretations. Special emphasis is placed on critical reading and essay writing to help students prepare for the AP examination.

Course Structure

This course is organized in units called modules. Each module can contain files, discussions, assignments, quizzes, and other learning materials. Students are expected to move through the modules in order.
