

Haverhill Public Schools Makes Quick Recovery from Ransomware Attack

Haverhill Public Schools used ClassLink to quickly recover from a ransomware attack that took out their virtual servers, halting remote learning for 8,000 students.

With cloud-based versions of those servers set up offsite through ClassLink for rostering and authentication, the district was back up and running within 24 hours without paying a ransom or communicating with attackers.
