## Call for Proposals

**Thank you for your interest in presenting at the 2020 Learning Impact Leadership Institute, 18-21 May 2020, in Denver, Colorado.**

The goal of the Learning Impact Leadership Institute (Learning Impact) is to understand the current state of the edtech sector, share technology projects that demonstrate the potential for improving learning impact, and identify productive collaborations to speed progress toward creating an open digital ecosystem. We anticipate over 600 executive-level attendees representing K-12 districts and schools, higher education (HED) institutions, government agencies, and edtech suppliers from around the world.

### Important Dates

- The deadline for submitting proposals is **Friday, 8 November 2019** (11:59 PM Eastern Time).
- Acceptance notifications will be sent by **Wednesday, 11 December 2019**.
- Presenters must confirm by **Thursday, 16 January 2020** their intent to present as invited.
- Confirmed presenters must register for Learning Impact by **Friday, 28 February 2020** before the early-bird registration period ends.

- Proposals must include complete contact information for all presenters. Proposals without contact information are not considered.
- If you are submitting a proposal on behalf of the lead presenter, do not enter your email address as the lead presenter's email. You will have an opportunity to provide your contact information as part of the submission process and will be copied on the acceptance notification sent to the lead presenter.

### Proposal Criteria

- We seek proposals from HED and K-12 academic, IT, assessment, continuing learning, digital curriculum and state leaders at all levels who are innovating with digital technology to support next-generation learning and can show evidence of progress.
- Edtech suppliers may submit a proposal along with a district, HED institution, state agency, or non-profit representative to showcase a partnership to evolve a digital ecosystem that is cost-effective, sustainable, and scalable to improve learning impact.
- Proposals without an institutional lead presenter will not be considered.
- A lead presenter is required for each proposal with a maximum of three additional co-presenters (optional).
- Proposals should demonstrate leadership and articulate a pragmatic strategy/project that has been implemented to address key challenges common to the education community to evolve their digital ecosystems to achieve better teaching and learning experiences.

### Presenter Responsibilities

- Selected presenters are responsible for registration, housing, and travel expenses. Breakfast and lunch are provided to all attendees throughout the Learning Impact Leadership Institute. IMS does not waive presenter registration fees.
- Breakout sessions are 30 minutes in length. Presenters agree they will not exceed the allotted time so that the next presenter has adequate time to set up and start their session on time.
- All presenters must bring their own laptop or tablet for their session and bring the appropriate cable(s) to connect to the projector.
- Presenters will be asked to complete a speaker profile in advance of the conference.

- Presenters will be able to provide an electronic copy of their presentation and/or handouts by uploading these to the online agenda for attendees to access during and after the conference.
