How Do You Know You're in Good Hands?

- 5. Is there end-to-end transparency of accessibility support before a user purchases or adopts?

Navigation Support

ASK: Is the platform and navigation designed with consideration for the accessibility needs and features of users?

Smart, intuitive design and functionality features can make a huge difference for students with disabilities.

- 1. Intuitive tools to help users navigate content quickly and easily, including a table of contents, scrubber bar, and search bar
- 2. A highly functional reading experience that is structured to be easily consumed via assistive technology; it may include mark-up with heading levels and hyperlinks (where supplied by the publisher)

Reading Options

ASK: Is the platform compatible with assistive technologies, like screen readers?

Conformance testing for platforms should leverage the variety of screen readers and other assistive technology in use today.

- 1. Platforms integrated with screen reader tools, such as Microsoft Narrator, JAWS, NVDA, TalkBack, and VoiceOver
- 2. Spoken word, vibrations, and other audible features to help students with visual impairments effectively use and interact with content
- 3. The ability to consume content in any standard book format, including PDF and EPUB
- 4. The ability to use other assistive technology, such as Braille displays

Content Controls

ASK: How do content controls or visual adjustments support low-vision users?

These features allow users to make adjustments to read in comfort, so the title or material can be adapted to each learner's unique needs.

- 1. Options to adjust text size
- 2. A wide variety of fonts to choose from, including OpenDyslexic
- 3. The ability to magnify content in the platform
- 4. A way to easily adjust margin size
- 5. Built-in functionality to change the display color and background color (including night mode)

Study Aids

ASK: Are study aids accessible yet rich enough to improve retention and enhance the reading experience?

Adopting programs that incorporate useful study aids can help students practice what they've learned and reinforce content absorption.

- 1. All the great study features of digital textbooks, including notetaking, highlighting, creating flashcards, and term look-up
- 2. Built-in text-to-speech functionality (Read Aloud) in any available language, with the ability to rewind, fast-forward, and pause
- 3. Highlighting of corresponding text in Read Aloud, so users can easily follow along with content
- 4. Search bars and shortcuts to find keywords and concepts anywhere they appear

Clear Accessibility Designations

Is there end-to-end transparency of accessibility support before a user purchases or adopts?

Providers need to identify the accessibility support publishers have included in a title, so users have confidence that their accommodations will be supported.

- 1. Details related to accessibility support displayed clearly on the detail page for a title before purchase
- 2. Ability to see and evaluate the accommodations publishers have included, such that faculty can determine if the content meets students' needs before an adoption, and students can make an informed purchase



Transparency of accessibility claims is paramount.
